LOWER LIMB VENOUS DUPLEX SCAN

Diagnosis: Right ankle swelling.

Right leg:

The deep veins: all patent and competent.

Saphenofemoral junction: patent and competent.

Great saphenous vein: the proximal great saphenous vein is both patent and competent. There is isolated incompetency of the distal great saphenous vein in the calf.

Saphenopopliteal junction: competent.

Small saphenous vein: no reflux detected.

Perforating veins: no incompetent perforators identified.

Left leg:

The deep veins: all patent and competent.

Saphenofemoral junction: patent and competent.

Great saphenous vein: the proximal great saphenous vein is both patent and competent. There is isolated incompetency of the distal great saphenous vein in the calf.

Saphenopopliteal junction: competent.

Small saphenous vein: no reflux detected.

Perforating veins: no incompetent perforators identified.

Conclusion:

Bilateral distal great saphenous vein incompetency.
