X-RAY RIGHT ANKLE

Clinical History: Suggested by recent USS 14/06/2022 due to cortical irregularity and ossicles and ongoing discomfort. ?chronic stress fracture.

Findings: There are no images or report of prior studies available for comparison at the time of this report interpretation.

There is approximate 10mm corticated chronic ossification adjacent to the distal tip of the medial malleolus which may be from remote injury. The calcaneus has enthesophyte at the attachment of the plantar fascia. The distal shaft of fibula has benign broad based small exostosis projecting laterally. The ankle joint has suspected minimal degenerative change.

No acute fracture or suspicious osseous lesíon is identified.
