In light of Alicia's past and current symptoms, it would be beneficial for us to do a comprehensive review of her general health. As we would like to eliminate any aggravating factors, pending your review and approval I would appreciate it if you would please consider organising the following assessments:

- Day 2: E2, FSH, LH, PRL, DHEA-S, SHBG, AMH
- Day 21: Progesterone
- CA-125 (general marker reproductive inflammation)
- CRP, ESR
- FBC
- UEC, LFT
- Vitamin D3 (25-OH)
- Folate + B12
- Vitamin D
- Iron Studies (full panel)
- Fasting blood glucose, Fasting Insulin, IGF-1, HbA1c
- Fasting cholesterol profile
- Full TFT (TSH, T4, T3) + antibodies
- Coeliac screen and gene profile
- Caeruloplasmin
- ANA/ENA
- Immunoglobulins

If there are any assessments you aren't comfortable ordering above please let me know and I can refer Alicia for private testing instead. Also, I would appreciate being copied in on the results as I have direct access to most of the major labs.

I have also suggested to Alicia she get an updated "deep pelvic ultrasound" (with bowel prep) to assess any progression of the adenomyosis.
