Clinical history:

Known endometriosis. Left sided lower abdominal pain, has had ablation

Examination:

CT Abdomen and Pelvis

Findings:

Portal venous phase CT scan of the abdomen and pelvis is performed with multiplanar reconstruction.

There is a small amount of fluid in the pelvis. There is no bowel obstruction. There is no colitis. There is no diverticulitis.

Appendix is identified and is normal with no evidence of acute appendicitis. There is an 18mm well defined cystic structure in the left ovarian or adnexal region likely representing an ovarian cyst. There is no abdominal or pelvic collection. There is no paraaortic lymphadenopathy. Liver demonstrates normal appearances. Pancreas is normal. Gallbladder is normal. Spleen is normal. Adrenals are normal. Kidneys demonstrate normal appearances with no hydronephrosis or hydroureter. Visualised lung bases are clear. No lytic or sclerotic bony lesions are identified.

Impression:

There is trace of non-specific fluid in the Pouch of Douglas. There is no acute abdominal or pelvic pathology identified. No cause for patient's symptoms is identified.

If there is concern for ovarian/ adnexal pathology, assessment with pelvic ultrasound can be considered.
