**OPERATIVE REPORT**

Procedure: Hysteroscopy, laparoscopic excision of endometriosis

The patient was placed in the lithotomy position, prepared and draped. The bladder was catheterised. Hysteroscopy revealed a normal cavity. A uterine manipulator was placed. A visual entry technique as per the AGES guidelines was used to access the abdominal cavity. The upper abdomen was scanned and appeared normal. The uterus was normal. The left adnexa was densely adherent to the uterosacral ligament with a large nodule involving the parametrium and densely adherent to the rectosigmoid. Four endometriomas ranging up to 4 cm were present in the left ovary. Further disease was present in the left side wall and bladder fold. The right ovary contained a 2cm endometrioma. The ovarian cysts were stripped free. All disease was excised. The left ureter was dissected free and appeared to have an early partial obstruction at the level of the parametrium. This area was dissected free and the obstruction relieved. The rectum was shaved and the serosa oversewn. The specimens were removed via a bag through a 12mm umbilical port. The sheath was suture closed.
