ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN

CLINICAL HISTORY

42 year old female ultrasound abdomen painful right hypochondrium.

FINDINGS

The visualised portion of the pancreas is unremarkable. The aorta is of normal diameter at 13mm. The liver measures 15cm longitudinally possessing a smooth echotexture with an appropriate echogenicity. Minor intrahepatic duct dilation predominantly left lobe with punctate foci of ringdown artefact (image 29) suggesting the presence of gas or calcification. The common bile duct is of normal diameter at 5mm. The gallbladder is surgically absent. Normal appearance of the kidneys bilaterally and spleen, no free fluid.

IMPRESSION

Mild prominence of the intrahepatic biliary tree potentially is in keeping with post cholecystectomy status, I note normal diameter of the common bile duct. Foci of ringdown artefact noted within the mildly prominent biliary tree potentially represents gas, CT evaluation of the abdomen is advised. Clinical correlation with patient recent EUA advised.
