History or Presenting Complaint

10yo F presents with 2nd seizure in 2mo

parents found pt this morning having a seizure

- found jerking body, eyes rolling

- lasted 1-2 min

- did not see initial start of it

yesterday was well in the day, however did not eat as much and went to bed late

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Discharge Summary

- felt nauseous at night, slept at 11am whilst reading
- otherwise well nil fevers, nil cough, coryzal symptoms
- BO, nil diarrhea, nil vomiting
- nil headache
- E+D well prior, did not eat as much

woke up this morning felt was like a dream and realised having seizure - some prodrome

- parents witnessed jerking, put finger into mouth
- nil tongue biting, nil incontinence, nil frothing at the mouth

some tiredness and fatigue post, now well and resolved

O/E: neurologically intact, able to mobilise as normal

Investigations

- Bloods: unremarkable
- UA: unremarkable
- resp PCR: pending at time of discharge

3. First seizure safety precautions, information given to parents

- resting
- no bath, shower door not locked
- if swimming people at arms distance

4. PARC followup appointment at 2:30pm - CSB building

Please seek medical attention if symptoms worsen or if there are any acute concerns.
