History

? Uterine pathology.

Findings

Cervix: 37mm - normal.

Uterus: I cannot identify any evidence of uterine pathology. Anteverted.

Volume: 43cc at 50 x 36 x 46mm (normal generally <80cc).

Myometrium: Generally homogeneous throughout.

Fibroids: There is a nodule present posteriorly in the upper body measuring 5 x 6mm likely a fibroid (grade 4 intramural). No other focal abnormality seen.

Endometrium: Endometrial depth of 5mm.

IUCD: No IUCD in situ.

Right Ovary: 3cc - normal.

Left Ovary: 3cc containing 2 dominant follicles of 7 x 10 x 8mm and 15 x 9 x 6mm. No suspicious features.

Both ovaries were mobile during this examination. Parenchymal echotexture is normal throughout. Neither ovary was tender to probe palpation.

Free movement of pelvic organs: YES.

Any free fluid: NO.

RIF: No abnormality seen.

CT may be indicated if there is still any ongoing concern towards the iliac fossae as bowel gas may obscure detail.

No other focal abnormality is seen. The remainder of the pelvis is generally unremarkable.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

In premenopausal patients, there is significant variation at different stages of the menstrual cycle.

- . During menstruation: 2-4mm
- . Early proliferative phase (day 6-14): 5-7mm
- . Late proliferative / preovulatory phase: up to 11mm
- . Following dilatation and curettage or spontaneous abortion: <5mm, if it is thicker consider retained products of conception

Please note that these measurements are a guide only, as endometrial thickness may be variable from individual to individual.

Postmenopausal

In postmenopausal patients, suggested endometrial thickness may be significantly affected by HRT which requires clinical correlation. The postmenopausal endometrial thickness is typically less than 5mm in a postmenopausal woman, but different thickness cut-offs for further evaluation have been suggested.

ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN

Clinical History: Dizziness and nausea.

Findings: The liver is of normal size, contour and echotexture. No discrete lesions are identified in the liver. The portal vein is of normal calibre and the flow is hepatopedal.

No calculi or polyps are seen in the gallbladder. The gallbladder wall is not thickened. There is no pericholecystic fluid. There is no tenderness in the region of the gallbladder fossa. The common bile duct is within normal limits for the patient's age.

The right kidney measures 11.3 cm and the left kidney 10.7 cm. There is no hydronephrosis.

The spleen is not enlarged and measures 9.7 cm.

The pancreas is well visualised and is of a normal appearance.

The abdominal aorta is not aneurysmal.

There is no free fluid. There is no lymphadenopathy.

Comment: No abnormalities are observed.
