Dear Sir / Madam,

The above consulted on 14 June with complains of severe dysmenorrhoea with dizziness and nausea / vomiting.

On examination, abdomen and pelvis were unremarkable.

Ultrasound examination showed bulky uterus with adenomyosis.  
Endometrium and ovaries are normal.

Investigations ordered include blood tests for hormones and CA 125 and MRI Abdomen and Pelvis.  
Her blood test results were normal. MRI showed uterine fibroid.

I have prescribed painkillers, anti nausea medicines and hormone replacement therapy.

She last consulted on 1 December.

Her cycles has been regular and monthly and posterior adenomyoma with severe dysmenorrhoea has improved with tramadol.  
She still has nausea with PMS.

On examination, abdomen and pelvis were unremarkable.

Ultrasound examination showed fibroid measuring 2cm and normal ovaries.

I have prescribed more Tramadol and antiemetics.
