XRAY RIGHT ELBOW, CT CHEST, ABDOMEN AND PELVIS, RIGHT SHOULDER AND THORACOLUMBAR SPINE Clinical Details: Fall from motorbike 8:00am today. Denied head strike or loss of consciousness. Pain in right lateral chest wall, mid back, right elbow and right flank.

Xray Right Elbow: Normal alignment. No evidence for joint effusion. No fracture.

CT Chest, Abdomen, Pelvis, Right Shoulder and Thoracolumbar Spine:

Technique: Post-contrast scanning through chest, abdomen and pelvis. Bony reconstructions to demonstrate right shoulder and thoracolumbar spine.

Findings: Mediastinal structures appear normal. In particular the aortic arch is unremarkable and the adjacent mediastinal tissues preserved. No pericardial fluid. There does appear to be some coronary artery calcification present, noted as an incidental finding. There is relatively extensive atelectasis at both bases and potentially some early patchy developing consolidation. No significant pleural effusion nor evidence of pneumothorax.

Liver and spleen are normal in size and uniform in density with no evidence for significant injury to either of these organs. There is a low density lesion high in the right lobe of liver which shows some peripheral discontinuous enhancement in keeping with an incidental haemangioma. This measures approximately 2.1cm. No biliary or pancreatic abnormality is seen. Adrenal glands and kidneys appear normal. No free intraperitoneal fluid or gas. Retroperitoneal structures unremarkable. Increased density in deep subcutaneous fat of right flank in keeping with localised haematoma. No underlying muscle or bony pathology is noted. No thoracic or lumbar spine fracture is noted. There are however multiple posterior right rib fractures involving 5th, 6th, 7th, 9th and 10th ribs. These are all undisplaced. No further definite rib fracture is seen. Bony pelvis is intact. Alignment at the right shoulder is preserved and no fracture is seen with background of mild glenohumeral and AC joint degenerative change.

COMMENT: Multiple undisplaced posterior right-sided rib fractures. Incidental haemangioma right lobe liver. Bibasal lung atelectasis. No further significant injury site identified.

XRAY CHEST

Clinical Details:

Post multiple rib fractures. Sats ok, but bibasal creps.

Report:

There is a small right and a trace left sided pleural effusion with subjacent atelectasis. Given the clinical history, this most likely represents a haemothorax. The known rib fractures are better demonstrated on the prior CT 15/10/23.
