Dear Dr Kaur,

Diagnosis:

1. Vaccine induced pericarditis

Medications: Colchicine 500mcg twice daily

I caught up with Mr Boric today over the phone. His vague symptoms of chest pains seem to be reducing in frequency but still is persistent. He reports that with physical activities, he feels a pushing discomfort in the left infra-axillary area which resolves with rest. With similar symptoms, he in the interim had presented to the LMH ED where evaluation did not reveal any abnormalities. CTPA done in that setting was also negative for any PE. His cardiac MRI is due on 07.03.2022 at the LMH.

I have today reassured him of his cardiac status. He could continue the Colchicine for a total of 3 months and cease. I have advised him to gradually exercise and see how he tolerates it. If the c-MRI also turns out to be normal, I plan to do an exercise stress echo for him to ensure no significant CAD. Hope to review him in 3- 4 week after the C-MRI.
