Problem List:

1. Vaccine induced pericarditis.

Current Medication: Colchicine 500 mcg twice daily.

I caught up with Mr Boric today over the phone. He reports that he has noticed generalised fatigue and mild discomfort on his left intraaxillary area with physical activities. With the Colchicine he has had significant improvement in his symptoms of chest discomfort but now he is beginning to notice some tummy discomfort. However, he denies any episodes of diarrhoea. Currently he takes his Colchicine twice daily after food.

He is due for his cardiac MRI today at the Lyell McEwin Hospital. I have today reassured him regarding his cardiac status and advised him to go through the MRI.

Meanwhile if he is develops any tummy discomfort with the Colchicine he could reduce it to once daily and continue it for another one month.

Hope to catch up with him in a few weeks' time once the MRI result is available. Thank you for your care.
