**Medical History**

1. Aortic stenosis, had TTE with A/Prd Nasis in November 2021, DVI 0.23 with MG 53 mm hg, RVSP 38 mm Hg, aortic valve calcium score 5920, on 1st June underwent stress echo, confirmed severe aortic stenosis, exercised for 9 min at Bruce protocol, reached 106% THR and 10 METs (expected for age 8.4 METs), no symptoms.
2. Asthma, chronic, precipitated by thunderstorms
3. Not covid vaccinated
4. Skin cancers resected, last hospital admission in 04/2021 at PMCC for BCC excised from ear

It was a pleasure to see ted again today. He remains well. he is doing a 6 km walk twice daily which he completes in 1 hour each. hed feels fitter now than he was 12 months earlier. He is asymptomatic.

His blood pressure was 127/64.

We discussed the implications of his aortic stenosis. his personal preference is to watch but agrees that it would be reasonable to consult with a heart Valve team at a tertiary hospital so he can make the best possible informed decision.

My plan is:

1. I will contact Prof. Dion Stub to ask for his advice and possible presentation at a Heart valve team meeting.
2. I will review Edward in 5 months, but will also inform him of the Heart Teams findings on the day of the meeting.
