Dear PETER KOPP,

JULIAN RYAN TUBMAM presented to the Emergency Department at THE PRINCE CHARLES HOSPITAL on the 4 NOV 2021 at 18:41. The presenting problem was 4/7 CHEST TIGHTNESS - ASSOC SOB - GP REF 6/7 MODERNA VACCINE HX DENIES.

The diagnosis was PERICARDITIS

Dear Dr,

Thank you for referral of this 24 y.o. with central chest pains following 1st dose moderna. He reports a 3 day history of intermittent chest tightness, which is worse on inspiration, with some associated exertional fatigue.

His ECG in dept was consistent with your own, showing ST elevation in leads V4-6, II, III and aVF as well as widespread PR depression.

CXR was normal and inflammatory markers were WNL.

His serial troponins were negative and his pain responded well to ibuprofen. Obs remained WNL and no evidence of pericardial effusion or RHF on examination.

I agree he appears to have a vaccine induced pericarditis. Cardiology consulted who are happy for DC with colchicine, ibuprofen and PPI cover.

I have safety netted regarding symptoms of colchicine toxicity and pericardial effusions.

I would appreciate if you could arrange an OP echo to ensure maintenance of systolic function.
