I saw Jacqueline today for follow up.

The repeat MRI shows no change in the small incidentally found left parietal convexity meningioma. We see it more clearly now that contrast was given.

I agree with the radiologist that it is stable compared to the previous scan of a year ago.

The MR angiogram shows no abnormality in the anterior cerebral artery region and the radiologist has reported this as nothing more than calcification in the dura which we see not uncommonly as a normal finding.

I reassured her that there is nothing to do about this small meningioma. Treatment options are surveillance, radiotherapy or surgery. With a small incidentally found lesion that is not producing any symptoms and not changing the most sensible thing is to keep this under surveillance.

Furthermore as it hasn't changed in twelve months I recommend we let two years go by and plan to repeat the scan in two year's time
