ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN

CLINICAL HISTORY:

Complains of reflux ? endoscopy normal, no benefit PPI, on examination tender right upper quadrant, ? gallbladder calculi.

FINDINGS:

The liver is normal in size and echotexture. No suspicious focal hepatic lesion is detected.

The gallbladder appears normal. No pericholecystic fluid is seen. The biliary ducts are not dilated and the common bile duct measures 0.3cm. Both kidneys are normal in size and echotexture. The right kidney measures 10.0cm in bipolar length. The left kidney measures 10.5cm in bipolar length. The corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. There are non- obstructing calculi at both kidneys. The calculus at the upper pole to interpolar region of the and another calculus at lower pole of the right kidney measures 0.3cm in diameter and the calculus at the lower pole calyx of the left kidney measures 0.4cm in diameter. No hydronephrosis or hydroureter is seen.

The spleen is normal in size and no focal lesion is seen. The pancreas is unremarkable.

The appendix is not visualised. There is no free fluid or loculated fluid collection in the right iliac fossa region.

COMMENT:

Non-obstructing bilateral renal calculi demonstrated. No biliary calculus or obstruction is seen as per concern.
