

Thanks for referring this complicated 57 year old lady who has had an "awful year" with various somatic complaints manifesting almost immediately after her first Pfizer vaccination on 13th January 2022.

Her symptoms are very capricious and complicated and she has apparently had two Emergency Department presentations and seen a number of other specialists but has had no real diagnosis or relief. She says she has had to give up her previous full time employment as a performing arts/circus teacher and coordinator and has at times been despairing and almost suicidal. Fortunately her mood is currently stable.

Tracy was previously a very active "outdoorsy type" but is now **almost housebound** with fatigue, migratory pain and transient neurological symptoms suggestive of **remitting relapsing neuritis**.

Her initial presentation was reasonably convincing of a pericarditis with pleuritic and positional central chest pain so I have presumptively started treating her as though she may have a post Pfizer pericarditis which would be most consistent with her initial symptoms and recent echocardiographic findings including a "brightened pericardium".

To this end I have given her a **prescription for a small dose of Colchicine 250mcg bd** and asked her to increase the dose to 500mcg bd if she has no issues with lower gastrointestinal side effects about which we had a lengthy discussion today.
