angular kyphosis at this level with collocated shallow Schmorl's node-like depressions - this is most likely indicative of juvenile discogenic disorder (aka Schuerman disease) with a small possibility they are the sequela of old prior discitis or trauma - either way there is no suggestion of active spondylitis and there is no spinal canal stenosis. No acute or malignant appearing abnormality of the thoracic cage.  
Technical factors - 0mg Metoprolol i.v and 2 spray GTN sublingual on the table. 75mL i.v contrast. Radiation dose for the angiogram component 229mGy.cm.
