There is a suggestion of adhesions between the parietal pericardium and her chest wall suggesting that she may previously have had an episode of pericarditis but that there was no evidence of active inflammation or pericardial constriction. There are no clinical signs of this either.

Tracy's 12 lead ECG shows no overt features of pericarditis and her blood tests including inflammatory markers and an autoimmune screen were all normal.

Tracy continues to experience manifold complaints and is engaging with online groups for post vaccination adverse events. I think her reading has actually made her more (rather than less) anxious and she is now seeking compensation for her significant financial outlays and loss of income.

Objectively speaking her pericardial adhesions and initial complaints satisfy a classification of 'possible pericarditis' which is the most I could say in this regard. I have given her my condolences but was unable to uncover enough objective cardiac pathology to explain the duration, severity and range of her post vaccination symptoms and poor response to therapy.

I would support her request for compensation but understand that the scheme is not particularly conducive to anything short of absolute evidence which I was unable to provide. She seems understandably disappointed with the outcome.

I haven't made an appointment to see Tracy again unless there are any new changes, questions or concerns which point to a specific cardiac complaint.
