Dear colleague,

It was a pleasure to review Miss Cracker in the Blood Pressure telephone clinic today.

Diagnoses:

Hypertension

- Aldo 230, renin 0.7, ARR 329
- Normal plasma metanephrine's

- Mild LVH on echo (on Amlodipine for 3 years)

Medications:

Amlodipine 10mg od

Side effects

Ramipril - cough

Losartan - cant recall what the side effect was ?dizzy/nausea

Started treatment for hypertension in 2020. Mean BP at the time was 140/96 mmHg. Not repeated since whilst has been on treatment.

She is under investigations for potential secondary causes of hypertension given her age. She is awaiting an MR renal angiogram (re-booked for 22/4/23) and 24 hour Ambulatory BP Monitor (need rebooking).

Has had a very stressful year, gets a lot of facial pain - under neurology (has nortriptyline). Also gets chest pain every day. The pain is in the middle of her chest, under her ribs, struggles to breath.

Then gets an ache. Pain is constant. Has been going on for around a year but goes up and down. Pain not clearly worse when walking. Seeing her GP tomorrow.

BP at home checked the last few days

- 136/97 mmHg
- 143/97 mmHg

Plan

- Face to face in 3 months (30 minutes)
- · Await MR renal angiogram
- 24 hour BP
- 7-day home BP diary
- If BP not to target Indapamide
