Amylase - Note: The elevation of serum amylase in acute pancreatitis is transient, usually returning to normal levels within 48 hours. Other causes of an elevated serum amylase, in the setting of an acute abdomen, include gastrointestinal perforation (including a ruptured peptic ulcer), intestinal obstruction, acute biliary disease, ruptured ectopic pregnancy and intestinal ischaemia or infarction. Serum amylase can also be increased with parotitis.
