Many thanks for your kind referral of Mr Romen Savesk, a 35 year old for the assessment and management of coronavirus vaccination side effects.

He has had 2 doses Pfizer coronavirus vaccination but the symptom started after the first dose and included left-sided sharp chest pain which was stabbing in nature. This pain occurs several times a day and initially lasted minutes to hours but now lasts seconds. He is also palpitations where his heart rate is fast and regular. His had feelings of the room spinning as well as ringing in his ears, headache, lethargy as well as shortness of breath on exertion. Fortunately his exercise tolerance is improving. He has had past chronic fatigue syndrome 10 years ago and there has been a recurrence of these symptoms following vaccination.

Past History:

Nil significant

Cardiac Risk Factors: Non smoker, No family history of IHD, No known diabetes, Normal cholesterol level, Normotension

Current Medications:

Melatonin 2mg Tablets 1 as needed

Allergies:

Nil Known

Romen weighed 63.7 kg with a BMI of 21.2 and a waist circumference of 78 cm. He looked well on examination with a supine blood pressure of 125/75 mmHg and a regular pulse rate of 69 bpm. On initial standing his blood pressure was 130/75 mmHg. With prolonged standing his blood pressure was 130/85 mmHg. On cardiovascular examination, his jugular venous pressure was not elevated. There were normal first and second heart sounds with no added murmurs. Respiratory examination was normal. There was no swelling of the ankles. Oxygen saturation was 99 %.

An ECG performed today revealed sinus rhythm with no significant abnormality.

IMPRESSION / MEDICAL ISSUES:

Probable coronavirus vaccination side effects.

PLAN:

Transthoracic echocardiogram. If no significant abnormality is found he may be reassured and hopefully his symptoms will settle down over the next few months.

I have not made another appointment to see him but am happy to be of assistance again should there be any further issues. He however knows to see you with regards to ongoing follow-up of his condition.
