

INTERPRETATION OF RESULTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: MODERATE TO HIGH RISK

Your DFI levels are moderately increased*. Your DFI represents a moderately increased risk for sperm DNA-damage related infertility and moderate-to-low odds ratio for pregnancy. We propose that your doctor proceeds in further investigation to determine possible sources of oxidative stress and sperm DNA damage such as inflammation and infection. Antioxidant and male normal flora supplementation to reduce oxidative stress damage is recommended

*Because of high levels of biological variation in sperm production and high susceptibility of sperm cells to environmental or circumstantial factors, sperm test results may vary between ejaculations and can fluctuate over time. For this reason, we recommend that pathological test results should be confirmed at least once, ideally following appropriate treatment.
