Technique

Procedure description

The patient was prepped and draped and placed in lithotomy position. In-out catheter.

A Betocchi irrigating hysteroscope was inserted into the uterine cavity under direct vision. The uterine fundus, then each ostia was inspected in systematic way. The hysteroscope was then withdrawn and endometrial biopsy performed. The umbilicus and skin was injected with LA. Initial entry was made as above. After thorough examination of the pelvis further ports were inserted under direct vision. Endometriosis excised from the sites below, including partial uterolysis. Excision of nodule from posterior cervix and small nodule overlying ureter on right pelvic sidewall. Excision of endometriosis from left uterosacral. Tube flushed with methylene blue. Patency confirmed. At the end of the procedure a small amount of fluid with LA was left in the pelvis

The abdomen was then deflated expulsion of as much CO2 gas.
