Your patient Rado Faletic presented to Calvary Emergency Department at 22/12/2021 10:57:00 AM and was discharged to Home Non adm visit on 22/12/2021.

Discharge Diagnosis:

Persistent lethargy/chest pain - aetiology unclear

Clinical Assessment:

Persistent symptoms including chest pain, lethargy, "brain fog" and SOB following COVID vaccinations. Not improving despite rest, and simple symptomatic treatment. PH - HTN, treated with ACEI
O/E: Flat affect but sitting in bed with no evidence of increased respiratory effort. Vital signs all normal range
HS dual - nil added. Chest - clear to exam. Abdo - mild deep tenderness but no guarding/rebound
Normal pulses. Nil oedema. Mobilised normally in ED
Bedside US - nil pericardial or pleural effusion ?mildly reduced LV systolic function
Bloods unremarkable - see below

Procedure and Treatment:

Review by cardiology AT - supports booking OP TTE
COVID swab collected (result pending)

Regular Medication Remains Unchanged: **Yes**

Discharge and Follow-up Plan:

Advised no evidence of major clinical abnormality requiring acute treatment
Request sent for OP TTE
Discharged home and advised to self isolate pending COVID swab result
Follow up with GP. Happy to review in ED as required.
