Clinical History

Unusual fluctuating neurological symptoms with weakness and collapsing episodes.  $\,$ 

Technique

Sagittal T1, multiplanar FLAIR, axial T2 and diffusion weighted images were acquired together with susceptibility weighted images.

Findings

The mid-line is central and the ventricles are within normal limits. There is no mass lesion. Occasional foci of increased signal intensity are seen in the subcortical white matter consistent with minimal chronic deep white ischaemic change. No recent infarct is seen on diffusion weighted imaging. There is no microhaemorrhage.

Minor mucosal thickening is seen in the paranasal sinuses.

The craniocervical junction is within normal limits.

CONCLUSION

Minor chronic deep white matter is chaemic change. No mass lesion or recent infarct is seen.

Minor mucosal thickening is seen in the paranasal sinuses.
