#### DIAGNOSES

1. Myeloablative sibling donor allogeneic stem cell transplant on 6 March 2013, for pro-B acute lymphoblastic leukaemia in CR1.
  - 1.1. Severe cutaneous toxicity, likely multifactorial with graft-versus-host disease and cytotoxic effect on biopsy.
  - 1.2. Severe pulmonary graft-versus-host disease. Ibrutinib dose weaning started on 31 January 2022. Ibrutinib ceased, ruxolitinib commenced 4 August 2022 (LVEF 36%). Commenced prednisolone 75 mg per day from 24 December 2022. CT January 2023 - pneumomediastinum. Commenced on ECP.
  - 1.3. Peripheral neuropathy, transfusion-associated iron overload, cataracts.
2. Pro-B acute lymphoblastic leukaemia diagnosed on 2 November 2012 - asparaginase-induced hepatotoxicity and dapsone-induced methaemoglobinaemia.
3. Pneumococcal sepsis requiring ICU stay, September 2019.
4. LV dysfunction with LV ejection fraction of 36% - 7 March 2022.
5. COVID infection, 31 August 2022.

I had a phone consult with Thom today. He is currently recovering from another respiratory infection. Overall, Thom feels that his respiratory status has gradually declined since Christmas last year.

He does not have GVH at any other sites. His lung functions are probably stable, though showed insignificant decrease in both FEV1 and FVC.

His CT scan demonstrated clear progression of his pulmonary changes including bronchiectasis with some air leak. I understand Professor Wark has organised for him to be reviewed by Professor Snell for opinion about lung transplant. I will wait to hear Professor Snell's opinion.

At this stage, I will review Thom again in four weeks.
