ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND

HISTORY

Epigastric pain and bloating.

FINDINGS

A pancreatic mass is not detected. The abdominal aorta is of normal dimensions.

The liver is not enlarged. The liver parenchyma is of increased echogenicity suggesting mild hepatic steatosis. Focal fatty sparing is seen

adjacent to the gallbladder fossa and porta hepatis. No other hepatic

lesion is detected.

There are no gallstones identified. No evidence of biliary dilatation. The CBD measures 5mm in diameter.

The spleen and both kidneys appear normal. Hepatopetal flow is seen in the

portal vein. No free fluid is seen within the abdomen.

COMMENT

Mild hepatic steatosis with focal fatty sparing.
