HISTORY:

TECHNIQUE:
Transabdominal and transvaginal scanning has been performed. Consent Obtained.

FINDINGS :

Uterus: The uterus measures 89 x 48 x 42 mm; 94 cc. The uterus position is anteverted. It moves freely and is non-tender.

Myometrium: The myometrium is homogeneous.

Endometrium: Secretory. 11.9 mm in thickness.

Cervix: The cervix is 30 mm in length.

Right Ovary : 25 x 20 x 27 mm; 7.1 cc.
There is free movement with applied pressure. It is non-tender.

Right Adnexa: No abnormality detected.

Left Ovary : 27 x 18 x 20 mm; 5.0 cc.
There is free movement with applied pressure. It is non-tender.

Left Adnexa: No abnormality detected.

Pouch of Douglas: There is a mild amount of anechoic free fluid with approximately 10 mL.

CONCLUSION:
Mildly bulky uterus.
No cause for symptoms detected.
There is some mild free fluid which is at the upper limit of normal.
A CT scan may be of value for further assessment.

Comments on Collection 10-Feb-25 0905 F:
 C Reactive Protein
 CRP is a more sensitive early indicator of an acute phase response than is ESR. It also returns towards normal more rapidly with improvement or resolution of the disease process.

If CRP is elevated, it can indicate disease activity of an inflammatory, infective or neoplastic nature.

Artefactually decreased CRP values occur when patients are treated with antibiotics containing carboxypenicillins including Ticarcillin.

EXAMINATION:

CT ABDOMEN AND PELVIS

Clinical History:

Free fluid on ultrasound significant right abdominal pain. Question musculoskeletal previous appendicectomy or hernia.

Technique:

Portal venous study.

Comparison:

Ultrasound of 10 February 20/25.

Findings:

Satisfactory appearances of the liver, adrenals, pancreas, spleen and kidneys.

Tampon in-situ. Anteverted uterus. Satisfactory appearances of the ovaries. It is noted that the volume of fluid on the previous ultrasound is within normal physiological limits.

Trace of fluid is seen in the pouch of Douglas on this CT.

Minor faecal loading in the proximal colon and the descending colon is collapsed not well identified.

Lung bases are clear. No destructive bone lesion.

CONCLUSION:

Small amount of fluid in the pouch of Douglas within physiological limits.

Minor faecal loading in the ascending and transverse colon? Contributing to symptoms. No definite cause for symptoms identified on CT.
