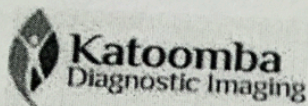

ULTRASOUND PELVIS

Clinical History: Endometriosis ?.

Findings:

Transabdominal and transvaginal pelvic ultrasound has been performed.
No previous imaging is available for comparison.

The anteverted anteflexed uterus measures 5.4 x 2.7 x 4.5cm with a volume of 34cc. Normal appearance of the myometrium. Endometrium measures 2mm in thickness.

Right ovary measures 3 x 1.9 x 2.3cm with a volume of 6.7cc. Right ovary is unremarkable.

Left ovary measures 3.2 x 1.5 x 2.3cm with a volume of 5.4cc. Left ovary was not mobile and appeared adherent to the uterine fundus.

Conclusion:

Immobile left ovary may be due to endometriosis. MRI is suggested for further evaluation if clinically appropriate.
