MRI BRAIN

Clinical Details: Worsening headache past three weeks, waking from sleep. Constant. Missing school. No rash or fever, bloods NAD. Exclude space occupying lesion.

Technique: Unenhanced study.

Findings: No intra- or extra-axial mass, collection or haematoma. No hydrocephalus. There is no recent infarct or abnormal parenchymal diffusion restriction. A few scattered punctate foci of white matter hyperintensity are non-specific, there is no significant neuroparenchymal signal abnormality. No evidence of remote parenchymal or pial haemorrhage. The midline commissural structures, sella, posterior fossa, craniocervical junction are structurally normal. No Chiari malformation. The major central intracranial arteries and dural venous sinuses appear patent. There is no significant paranasal sinus inflammatory disease, no otomastoid effusion.

Comment: No significant intracranial abnormality. No intracranial mass or hydrocephalus.
