Gastroscopy and Colonoscopy Report

Indication: Blood in stools.

Gastroscopy

Oesophagus: Normal
GE Junction: Normal at 38cm, no hiatus hernia. No oesophagitis noted
Stomach: Unremarkable
Incisura: Normal
Pylorus: Normal
Duodenum: Normal duodenal appearance

Colonoscopy

Intubation: Anus to caecum
Preparation: Good

Findings

Unremarkable anus and rectum
Large polypoid tumour on lateral wall of sigmoid colon (not circumferential)at approximately 20cm from anal verge on flexible scope. Multiple biopsies taken and colon marked with tattoo.
A second 5mm polyp snared from mid-transverse colon and base biopsied
A very small 2mm polyp removed also from transverse colon with biopsy forceps.
The caecum was well visualised and appears normal.

Assessment:

Sigmoid colon tumour highly suspicious of malignancy
2 small transverse colon polyps removed

Plan:

Patient to return to Australia shortly. For referral and urgent attention upon arrival.
