Thank you for referring Shae who we only saw on the 30th of last month and we have gone to theatre today for a laparoscopy and excision of endometriosis plus dye studies and hysteroscopy D&C.

She has been trying for a pregnancy over the last six months and has never been pregnant. Her fertility workup investigations have shown the possibility of some superficial endometriosis and clinically she does have some bowel symptoms and also deep dyspareunia.

At hysteroscopy she has a normal sized antverted uterus with normal cavity, endometrium and Ostia. Laparoscopy shows free spill of fluid from the fallopian tubes and normal antverted uterus, normal tubes and right ovary.

There was endometriosis superficially in the pouch of Douglas. She had a nodule of endometriosis on the left pelvic sidewall and the bowel was also adherent to the left ovary and pelvic sidewall. There was also a small endometromia on the left ovary. All of her endometriosis has been excised and the endometromia removed. The bowel adhesions have been freed a little but not completely as they would just return. The adhesions that remain are quite loose and I don't think there would be any problem in doing a trans-vaginal egg pickup.

I expect that she will go home today and I plan to see her in four weeks time for review and will keep you informed of her progress.
