# ULTRASOUND RIGHT SHOULDER

### HISTORY:

Right shoulder pain.

## COMPARISON:

None available.

## FINDINGS:

The long head of biceps tendon is intact and located in the bicipital groove.

The rotator cuff tendons are intact. There is no evidence of tendinopathy.

There is mild thickening of the subacromial-subdeltoid bursa, with bursal impingement on  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{S}}$ abduction.

The AC joint is normal.

Mildly restricted shoulder abduction. There is pain on external rotation.

- 1. No evidence of rotator cuff pathology.
- 2. Mild subacromial-subdeltoid bursitis with impingement.

No other abnormality identified to account for the patient's symptoms.
