ULTRASOUND RIGHT SHOULDER

Clinical Details:

History of pain anterior shoulder but normal movement of the shoulder.

Findings:

No intact fibres of supraspinatus are visible, consistent with a chronic full thickness tear. The infraspinatus tendon is thickened and heterogeneous, with some internal echogenic foci. The subscapularis and teres minor tendons are normal.

The long head of biceps tendon sheath contains a small volume of fluid.

There is minor subacromial bursal thickening. Minor bursal bunching on abduction.

There is degenerative change in the acromioclavicular joint and humeral head. Small volume posterior joint fluid.

## Conclusion:

. Subacromial bursal thickening may reflect bursitis.

. Features of chronic rotator cuff tendinopathy, with a chronic full thickness tear of supraspinatus and features of infraspinatus tendinopathy.
