- Likely traumatic from IDC insertion
- Continue to monitor if ongoing

OT Recommendation:

Recommendation remains for inpatient rehab in context of critical illness de-conditioning and reduced exercise tolerance with goal to optimise functional performance and independence prior to returning home however- OT also acknowledges Kalanni's autonomy to make her own informed decisions and supports discharge home with dignity risk into care of family. Aware can re-present to ED if not managing.
