Ferritin result is consistent with iron deficiency. Recent prior laboratory history of low Ferritin noted. During reproductive years, iron deficiency in women is usually due to menorrhagia. Other causes include: other blood loss (e.g. H. pylori, occult blood), pregnancy/lactation, and decreased absorption (e.g. diet, coeliac).
