ULTRASOUND RENAL TRACT

History:

Post prostatectomy. Urinary retention?

Findings:

Both kidneys have a normal size with the right measuring 124mm and the left 130mm. There is a cyst in the mid pole of the left kidney measuring 13mm. It contains faint internal septations but no concerning features. There is a benign cortical cyst lower pole right kidney measuring 17mm. No hydronephrosis, calculus, or suspicious mass in either kidney. The bladder is suboptimally filled with a volume of 90ml. No gross abnormality identified within this limitation. Post void residual 4ml. This is non-specific given the low starting volume. There is a rounded structure at the bladder base measuring 40 x 42 x 36mm (31ml). Ordinarily this would be reported as a normal volume prostate although the history states post prostatectomy. For surgical correlation in the first instance.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Bladder suboptimally assessed given the low starting volume.**
- 2. No hydronephrosis.**
- 3. No sinister findings.**
- 4. Rounded structure at the bladder base measuring 31ml would ordinarily be reported as a normal prostate, however, the history states prostatectomy and as such, urological / surgical correlation is advised in the first instance.**

EXAMINATION:
CT ABDOMEN & PELVIS

CLINICAL HISTORY:
Per rectal bleed, abdominal pain. Tender right iliac fossa.

TECHNIQUE:
Multiphasic contrast CT abdomen and pelvis before and after administration of contrast performed

FINDINGS:
There is no evidence of any active extravasation or pseudoaneurysm identified. Uncomplicated sigmoid and large bowel diverticulosis. No significant small bowel wall thickening or lesion.
No free fluid or focal collection
Liver, gallbladder, pancreas, spleen, bilateral adrenal glands do not reveal any significant abnormality.
Bilateral renal cysts, 1 of them in the midpole of the left kidney demonstrates few septations. No hydronephrosis. Partially distended urinary bladder demonstrating circumferential wall thickening with Peri vesicle fat stranding suspicious for cystitis. Mild prostatomegaly.
No significant lymphadenopathy.
No aggressive destructive osseous lesion.

IMPRESSION:
No evidence of any bowel haemorrhage. No free fluid or focal collection.
Partially distended bladder demonstrating apparent wall thickening with perivesical fat stranding suspicious for cystitis. Correlation with urine MCS recommended.
Bilateral renal cysts few of which appear complex with few septations. An ultrasound KUB suggested for better evaluation. Urinary bladder could also be evaluated in a distended state.

CYSTOSCOPY

Operation Details

INDICATION: 70 yo M, Investigation for LUTS, in particular urgency, settling however. Ongoing Incontinence (doesn't wear pads, but goes through 2 undies a day), hasn't been doing Pelvic floor exercises. Nocturia x3-4, daytime drowsiness, unsure if snores. Hx 160g HOLEP TURP (benign) oct 2024

PMHx: AF - on rivaroxaban

MEDS: Rivaroxaban, fish oil, allopurinol, HCT (moduretic), Flexanide, Metoprolol

FINDINGS

AU - small scattered ?sinus in anterior aspect ?significant

PU - wide open prostate fossa with regrowth left lateral lobe and anteriorly. BN minimal ROM but no overt BN contracture
Bladder - x2 UOs, Bladder NAD, large capacity, nil large mass lesions, trigone still showing signs of previous HOLEP changes that would be consistent with urgency symptoms
