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There is no suggestion of a facet capsulitis or of active enthesitis on the lumbosacral spinal ligament attachment.

## Comment:

The vertebral body corner marrow signal abnormalities between the L2/L3 and L4/L5 levels raise the possibility of Romanus lesions arguably with associated Andersson lesion formation at the inferior L2 endplate. It may be worthwhile correlating with relevant clinical serum markers for seronegative spondyloarthropathies in the first instance.

Some spondylosis at the lumbosacral junction with disc dehydration and an uncomplicated generalised disc bulge with features favoured to reflect associated Modic 1 degenerative endplate signal.
