MRI LUMBAR SPINE

CLINICAL HISTORY: Worsening sudden loss of sensation bilateral lower limbs and power with recurrent

falls

TECHNIQUE: Non-contrast scan.

FINDINGS: Comparison is made with the previous study of 29/7/2022.

L1-2: Normal.

L2-3: No significant disc protrusion or neural compression.

L3-4: Severe central canal stenosis secondary to a combination of annular disc bulge and posterior element hypertrophy. This appears worse than before, with increased effacement of the posterior epidural fat pad, and increased redundancy of the cranial cauda equina nerve roots. Mild bilateral noncompressive foraminal stenosis, similar to the previous scan.

L4-5 and L5-S1: There has been previous posterior lumbar interbody fusion and overlying laminectomies. Intervertebral cage insertion at L4-5. No high-grade stenosis to suggest definite neural compression.

CONCLUSION: L3-4 severe central canal stenosis, which appears increased compared to the previous scan.
