Indications: Dysphagia, Iron deficiency without anaemia

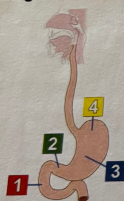
Medication: Monitored Anaesthesia Care
Report: After obtaining informed consent, the scope was introduced through the mouth, and advanced to the second part of duodenum. The upper GI endoscopy was accomplished without difficulty. The patient tolerated the procedure well.

Findings:
- The oesophagus was normal. Empiric Savary dilatation to 18mm performed without resistance. Nil mucosal tears on reinspection. Mid and distal oesophageal Bx performed.
- Two localised, small non-bleeding erosions were found in the gastric antrum. There were no stigmata of recent bleeding. Biopsies were taken with a cold forceps for histology.
- The examined duodenum was normal. Biopsied.

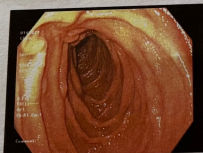
Complications: No immediate complications.

- Return for Gastroenterology Clinic follow up in 4-6 weeks please! weeks. Please call to book appointment.

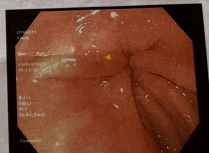

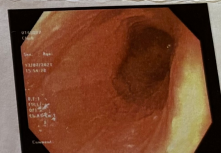
Upper Gastrointestinal Tract



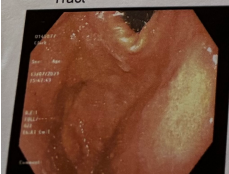
1 2nd Portion of the Duodenum : Normal
