I forgot to write this on your handout for George.

The spots look to be molluscum contagiusm. Very harmless and common but tends to irritate kids and does spread, so best to deal with it rather than wait 1-2 years for it to clear itself.

Most popular remedy is to dab olive leaf extract on it daily, or as often as you can. It tends to clear the spots very rapidly when used alongside a zinc supplement.
