Transabdominal and transvaginal scans were performed.
The uterus is anteverted and normal in size and echotexture.
No focal myometrial lesion seen.
Endometrium is proliferative and measures 7.2mm in thickness.
Both ovaries and adnexal regions are normal.
No adnexal mass or pelvic fluid collection seen. Cervix shows a few subcentimetre cystic foci, likely nabothian follicles.

Conclusion:

No significant pelvic abnormality detected. No pelvic cause for abdominal pain or bloating identified.

Thank you for asking me to see Maria with regard to a persistent test for high risk HPV DNA that is positive for the strains other than HPV16 and 18 and negative liquid based cytology. I have previously seen Maria in 2013 when she had some possible high grade changes on smear but she had not attended for follow up. Maria tells me she has had normal smears until these last two in the intervening time. Maria has not had the cervix cancer vaccination, she has regular periods and is still on the combined oral contraceptive pill with no intermenstrual or post coital bleeding.

Colposcopy showed some very mild changes consistent with cervicitis. There was no evidence of any cervical, vaginal or vulval dysplasia. I have conveyed my findings to Maria and I have asked her to see you for a repeat test in twelve months time.

Once again thank you for your referral Andrea.

Thank you for referring Ms Nicoli back to see me.

Problems:

1. a) 10+ years of intermittent abdominal bloating likely secondary to irritable bowel syndrome.
b) Minimal clinical response to a trial of low FODMAP diet through 2017.
c) Plan for gastroscopy, small bowel biopsy and colonoscopy.
2. a) Large juvenile polyp removed in Italy aged 12.
b) Normal colonoscopy 2009.
3. a) Abdominal ultrasound November 2016, incidental 7mm diameter likely hemangioma segment 8 liver.
b) February 2018 abdominal ultrasound showed slight increase in hemangioma size to 9mm.
4. Oral contraceptive pill
5. Non-smoker, social alcohol

Maria came to see me with a number of issues. With regards to the small likely hemangioma in segment 8 of her liver, there has been a slight increase in size to 9mm. I doubt this is of any significance but after some discussion with Maria I have elected to obtain an MRI of her liver to better define the lesion. She will have this through St Vincent's Private Radiology.

With regards to her longstanding abdominal symptoms, she continues to have central abdominal pain with postprandial bloating. Her bowel habit is regular passing one stool a day and there is no rectal bleeding. She has not lost any weight. She did trial a low FODMAP diet but this did not seem to really help her. I am not sure if coeliac disease has ever been formally excluded but I have now arranged for her to have a gastroscopy and colonoscopy through Hobson Healthcare in Sydenham.

Maria came for a gastroscopy and colonoscopy.

Problems:

- a) 10+ years of intermittent abdominal bloating likely secondary to irritable bowel syndrome.
b) Minimal clinical response to a trial of low FODMAP diet through 2017.
c) March 2018 gastroscopy and colonoscopy unremarkable.
- a) Large juvenile polyp removed in Italy aged 12.
b) Normal colonoscopy 2009.
- a) Abdominal ultrasound November 2016, incidental 7mm diameter likely hemangioma segment 8 liver.
b) February 2018 abdominal ultrasound showed slight increase in hemangioma size to 9mm. March 2018 MRI liver demonstrates liver lesion likely consistent with hemangioma.
- Oral contraceptive pill
- Non-smoker, social alcohol

Maria's gastroscopy and colonoscopy were unremarkable. Histopathology showed no evidence of coeliac disease, helicobacter pylori or microscopic colitis. I suspect her bloating is secondary to irritable bowel syndrome. I also enclose a copy of her MRI liver which showed the lesion in the liver to be most likely a hemangioma. Maria expressed the view to be followed up with yourself. I would be happy to see her again in the future if required.
