Thank you for referring Gillian Murray for an MRI of the left shoulder.

MRI LEFT SHOULDER:

History:

Pain and tenderness for a year, limited her movements, mild weakness in her left upper arm, pins and needles occasionally.

Findings:

Biceps tendon is intact and satisfactory. Biceps labral anchor is within normal limits. There is some minor high signal seen within the distal supraspinatus with fibre irregularity of its bursal fibres anteriorly. This is in keeping with a small bursal surface partial tear measuring approximately 5 x 7mm in size. Fluid is seen in the subacromial bursa. Remainder of the supraspinatus is intact. Infraspinatus is intact.

The AC joint shows moderate degenerative change. Acromion has a type I configuration. No muscle tear is seen. Subscapularis is normal.

No other significant findings of note.

CONCLUSION:

A small partial tear of the bursal surface distal supraspinatus. No other significant findings of note.
