Shoulder Ultrasound Clinical History:

Moderate subacromial bursitis. Had physio, remedial massages CS injection Ongoing pain ? Cause Findings:

There is subacromial bursal thickening with pain and bursal bunching during shoulder abduction in keeping with bursitis.

The long head of biceps tendon is intact and normally positioned within the bicipital groove. There is no significant effusion of the long head of biceps tendon sheath.

The supraspinatus, infraspinatus and subscapularis tendons are grossly intact.

There is no gross glenohumeral joint effusion and a posterior para labral cyst. There is no gross capsular thickening or effusion at the acromioclavicular joint. CONCLUSION:

Subacromial bursitis.

Grossly intact rotator cuff and long head of biceps tendons.
